37 units, 377 youth, virtually all doing two or more courses, and 110 adults orienteered for a total of 487 orienteers including 30 youth and 15 adults from two CAP units from Anne Arundel and Howard Counties. Partial refunds for our orienteering event will be credited to troops at the BAC Scout Shop, or sent via mail for out-of-council troops.

Go in pairs, but be sure to pay for and get one map per scout. They always uses maps just like ours, and always have courses and instruction for beginners,
